Sub: - LAC - ADF - Exclusion of projects with commercial objectives-Instructions issued.

Ref: - GO(P) No. 332/12/ Fin dated 11.06 2012.

In the Government order read above, Government have issued guidelines of the newly introduced scheme of Legislative Assembly Constituency- Asset Development Fund (LAC-ADF) aiming at creation of fixed assets for long term use like buildings, roads, bridges, water supply, sanitation, irrigation, infrastructure, machinery and equipments and fixtures of permanent nature that forms part of infrastructural facilities of Government essential for imparting effective service to the public. Under this scheme each MLA can suggest works to the extent of ₹ 5 crore each year to be taken up in the respective Assembly Constituency.

2. Government have received several proposals from the Hon'ble MLAs for projects with commercial objectives such as construction of Shopping Complex etc using LAC ADF which are inconsistent with the declared objectives of the scheme. In the circumstances, Government clarify that proposals on projects with commercial objectives such as construction of Shopping Complexes etc which are not directly beneficial to the public are not allowed to be taken up under the Legislative Assembly Constituency-Asset Development Fund (LAC-ADF) Scheme.
