Public Works Department - Guidelines for Standardization of observed data for items of regular use and updation in PRICE software - Orders Issued

<u>ORDER</u>

As per the letter read as 1st paper above, the Chief Engineer (Administration) has submitted a proposal for standardization of the data for regularly occurring non-schedule items and update in PRICE software.

2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to issue the following guidelines for standardization of the data for regularly occurring non-schedule items and update in PRICE software:

i) The standardisation of non-schedule items of works shall be done by the Departments depending upon its core functions. Hence, the non-schedule items of works related to Roads, Bridges and Buildings construction shall be standardised by Public Works Department. The non-schedule items related to anti-sea erosion works, river and backwater protection works, navigation works and irrigation works shall be standardised by the irrigation department. The non-schedule items related to water supply, sanitary and drainage works shall be standardised by the Kerala Water Authority. Non-schedule items related to power production, transmission and distribution shall be standardised by KSEB.

ii) The standardisation of non-schedule items by the department as noted above shall be done by the Chief Engineers Committee of the respective departments.

iii) The Chief Engineers Committees after approving the standardised data and rates of non-schedule items_pertains to the core functionalities of their department, shall communicate the same to the PRICE-Project Management Unit of PWD for incorporating the same in PRICE software. The PRICE -PMU and NIC shall take necessary steps to publish the standardised data and rates of non-schedule items in PRICE software so that the same can be used by all departments and organisations who uses PRICE software for the management of public works.

iv) Any discrepancies in the data/rate of such approved observed data shall be brought to the attention of the Finance Department by the PRICE-PMU for reconciliation.
