## (1) Well marked Low pressure system over southeast Arabian Sea and rainfall over Kerala, Lakshadweep, Tamilnadu & Puducherry

## **Weather Systems**

Yesterday's **low pressure area** over southeast Arabian Sea & neighbourhood became Well marked in the early morning of today and lay centred over southeast and adjoining eastcentral Arabian sea in the morning today. It is very likely to concentrate into a Depression and move northwestwards during next 24 hours. It is very likely to intensify into a **Cyclonic Storm** and move towards Oman Coast thereafter.

## (ii) Wind warning

- Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely over Lakshadweep and southeast Arabian Sea on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> October.
- Squally wind speed reaching 40-50 kmph gusting to 60 kmph very likely over central Arabian Sea on 6<sup>th</sup>. The wind speed will gradually increase becoming 60-70 kmph gusting to 80 kmph on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2018. It will also increase thereafter.

# (iii)Sea condition

• The sea condition would become rough to very rough from today the 6<sup>th</sup> October over southeast Arabian Sea and adjoining central Arabian Sea. It will become gradually high over central Arabian Sea from 7<sup>th</sup> evening/ 8<sup>th</sup> morning.

# (iv) Fishermen Warning

- The fishermen are advised not to venture into deep sea areas of southeast and Lakshadweep area during 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> October and into east central Arabian Sea from 6<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> October and west-central Arabian Sea from 8-11 October.
- The fishermen out at deep Sea are advised to return to coast.

# (2) Low Pressure System over Bay of Bengal around 8<sup>th</sup> October 2018

Another low pressure area is likely to form over central and adjoining south Bay of Bengal and neighborhood around 8th October. It is likely to become more marked and move to towards Odisha & adjoining north Andhra Pradesh Coasts during the subsequent 72 hours.
